Laboratory water is **collected, cleaned and reused**. Rain is also captured from roofs and outside secondary containment, cleaned and used to reduce water purchases.

At our Palmital, Brazil site, we introduced processes where our rainwater and all clean water discharges **are used to water banana fields**, supporting farms in the area.
